

COVID-19 EMERGENCY UPDATE FOR MORTON COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE CENTRE PATIENTS

At the Morton Community Healthcare Centre, public safety is our first priority. The COVID-19 emergency has necessitated the following changes:

1. Doctors will be interacting with most patients over the phone. Patients will be notified if their appointment will be handled over the phone. The only patients who should come to their doctors' office are those with a confirmed appointment. If patients have a scheduled appointment from March 17 to mid-April, they should call their doctor's office to confirm.
2. No one should drop into the clinic without first confirming their appointment. Do not attend the clinic to book appointments or to drop off paperwork. Patients must instead call their doctor's office.
3. If you have any of the following: fever, cough, shortness of breath, flu-like symptoms, or have travelled out of Canada in the last 14 days, DO NOT attend an appointment at the clinic. Call your doctor.
4. The Blood Letting Lab is temporarily closed. Those needing blood work will be directed by their doctors to Peterborough Life Labs at 849 Alexander Ct, #106, Peterborough. Please visit <https://www.lifelabs.com/> for directions and hours.
